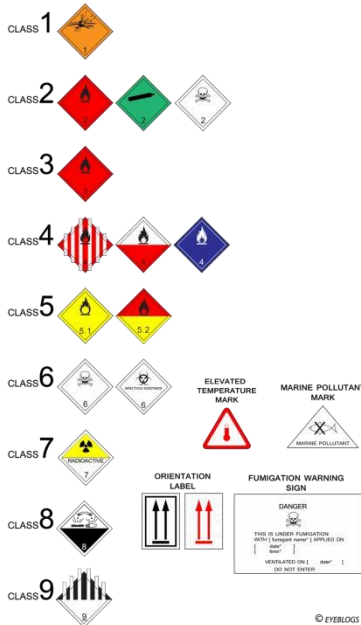


DANGEROUS GOODS

TLILIC0001: Licence to Transport Dangerous Goods by Road



Course Objective

This course provides the knowledge of dangerous goods road transport legislation and the Australian Dangerous Goods Code (ADG 7).

The dangerous goods classes covered are 2,3,4,5,6, 8 and 9.

Course Outcome

On successful completion of this course students will be issued with a Statement of Attainment.

Achieving this unit of competency is a necessary requirement for obtaining a licence. However, it is only one of several criteria for obtaining a DG driver licence. More information can be sourced from the regulator in each jurisdiction regarding other criteria that apply which can vary between states and territories.

- Emergency procedures (eg.: HAZCHEM, Transport Emergency Response Plans)

- Transport procedures/rules
- Prohibited and restricted routes
- Bulk transfer procedures
- Protective clothing and equipment
- Fire Extinguisher selection/location
- Documentation/Emergency Procedure Guides
- Segregation of incompatible loads
- Load stowage and restraint

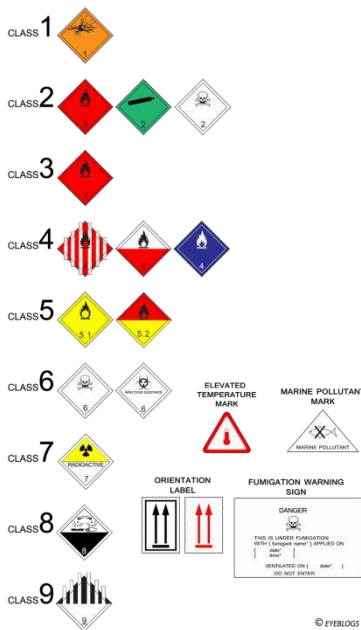

- Transport of packages, large tanks, portable tanks intermediate bulk containers
- Ullage considerations
- Preventing fire during transfer (switch loading and static electricity)

Methods of Assessment may include

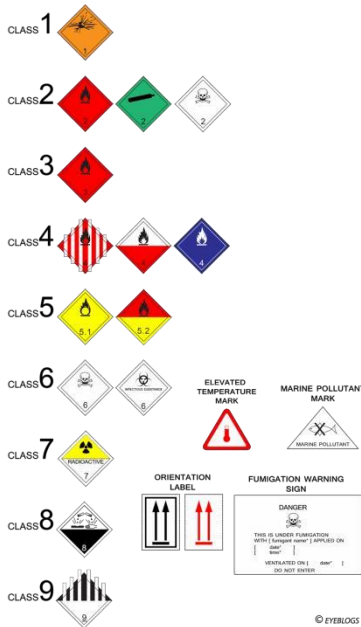
- Questioning
